

## Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Sciences

The University of North Carolina at Charlotte invites applications for a nine-month, tenure track Assistant Professor position in the Department of Public Health Sciences. The Assistant Professor will engage in scholarship that advances the Department's portfolio of health services research; teach in our BS in Health Systems Management, Master in Health Administration, and/or planned MPH Health Policy concentration program(s); and contribute professional service to the institution, community, and discipline. The expected start date is August 15, 2024.
